Bill Analysis

SB 1451 provides that upon an application for a driver license or a renewal of a driver license, proof of coverage under a motor vehicle liability policy shall be submitted with the application. The measure directs insurers to notify the Department of Public Safety if the coverage is terminated within 10 days of the cancellation. The person previously covered under the policy shall have 30 days to show proof of coverage. Failure to provide proof within the 30 days shall result in the revocation of the person's driver license. The measure also creates a new category of coverage. Non-owner's policy shall insure the person named as insured therein against loss from the liability imposed upon the person by law for damages arising out of the use by the person of any motor vehicle not owned by the person.
