**Bill Analysis**

SB 1512 states legislative intent that in establishing the minimum required score on a College Level Examination Program (CLEP) examination for granting course credit for lower division courses that institutions within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education will not require a score higher than the minimum score recommended by a nonprofit higher education association that makes recommendations on college-level equivalencies. The measure allows a president of an institution to determine if a higher score is necessary to indicate a student is prepared to be successful in a related, more advanced course. It requires institutions to post their CLEP examination policies on their websites.
