## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1532 directs courts to waive all fines, fees, and court costs regardless if a person has been denied of waiver of such costs after November 1, 2022, if such a person served a period of imprisonment and was released after serving the term of imprisonment. Such persons must also have complied with all probation or supervision requirements since being released and made installment payments on a timely basis for 24 consecutive months. Additionally, the measure also directs courts to waive all fines, fees, and court costs if the person made installment payments on a timely basis for 48 consecutive months.
