Bill Analysis

SB 1557 directs the Department of Public Safety to query the Electronic Verification of Vital Events (EVVE) system prior to issuance of a new driver license application or state-issued identification, a renewal of a driver license or state-issued identification, or an application for a lost or destroyed driver license or a state-issued identification card. If EVVE cannot verify the applicant's birth certificate, EVVE shall provide a question-and-answer-based verification process that with near certainty, can establish the validity of the professed identity of applicants.
