Bill Analysis

SB 1565 modifies the duties of the Attorney General by requiring the Attorney General to cross-deputize police officers of the police department of any municipality or any officer deputized by the county sheriff or a designee subject to an interlocal governmental agreement with the Attorney General's Office in an effort to combine city, county, and state law enforcement efforts and to encourage cooperation between city, county, and state law enforcement officials. The measure provides that liability for the conduct of any municipal police officer cross-deputized under the terms and conditions of an interlocal governmental agreement shall remain with the employer of the officer.
