Bill Analysis

SB 1566 provides that a parent or legal guardian of a child may delegate any of the powers regarding the care and custody of his or her child in the event the parent or legal guardian is incapacitated. The delegation shall take effect when the attorney-of-fact has acquired sufficient documentation showing the incapacity of the parent or legal custodian. The measure provides that such delegation may not exceed 1 year beginning from the time the attorney-of-fact is notified of the incapacity.
