**Bill Analysis**

SB 157 modifies the authority of the Governor to remove appointed members from the State Board of Education. The measure allows the Governor to remove members for cause, including being found guilty of a felony or any offense involving moral turpitude; being found guilty of malfeasance, misfeasance or nonfeasance in relation to Board duties; being found mentally incompetent; or failing to attend 3 successive Board meetings without just cause.
