Bill Analysis

SB 1582 allows a member of a school district board of education to be removed from office by a recall petition that demands removal of the member and election of a successor. The measure requires the petition to be signed by at least 10% of the qualified electors of the school board district based on the votes cast at the last school board district election. The board of education must fix the date of the election within 10 days of receiving the petition. The incumbent member sought to be removed can be a candidate in the election. The measure states that if no candidates file, the incumbent member continues to serve. If someone other than the incumbent is elected, the successor is to take office within 10 days and serve the remainder of the unexpired term.
