**Bill Analysis**

SB 159 prohibits the imposition of certain sentences on any person younger than 18 years of age. Prohibited sentences include life without parole and mandatory minimums carrying a term of imprisonment greater than 20 years. Additionally, the court is required to consider a number of circumstances outlined in the measure prior to imposing a sentence.
