**Bill Analysis**

SB 1595 modifies emergency succession procedures by requiring chief officers to designate a deputy, chief administrative officer, or such other personnel of the agency of the officer as an emergency interim successor. The measure also provides that the Governor shall fill any vacancies in a municipality that does not provide for filling vacancies arising from and during an emergency. The measure strikes reference to the term “unavailable” from the Emergency Management Interim Legislative Operations Act.
