**Bill Analysis**

SB 1603 requires each state agency to disclose the federal or state authority for any part of the agency operations as requested by any member of the Legislature through proper passage of a resolution. Agencies must provide the constitutional provision, statute, and/or rule authorizing the agency operation in question. Heads of state agencies shall have 10 days after receipt of the resolution to respond. Failure to respond will subject said persons to removal.
