**Bill Analysis**

SB 1606 creates the Constitutional Heritage and Legacy Display Act. The measure directs superintendents of public schools to place a durable poster or framed image showing the national motto, an accurate representation of the United States Flag, the Declaration of Independence, the Bill of Rights, and the Constitution. Such items will only be displayed if sufficient funds are donated to state agencies, local schools, or local school boards.
