**Bill Analysis**

SB 1622 modifies the powers and duties of a school district board of education to allow boards to lease real or personal property that is not being used by the district and is deemed vacant to a charter school. The bill directs each school district board of education to annually publish a list of buildings and portions of buildings owned by the district that are not being used by the district and are vacant and requires boards of education to make the lists available to charter school applicants and charter schools located within the district. The bill directs boards of education to notify charter school applicants and charter schools located within the district of their right of first refusal to lease a building or portion of a building included on a list. The measure requires that the charter school be charged rent below fair market value.
