**Bill Analysis**

SB 1624 designates the Board of Agriculture as the “State Education Agency” under the National School Lunch Act. The measure authorizes the Board of Agriculture to enter into any agreements as necessary to secure benefits of the school lunch program and creates the School Lunch Workshop Revolving Fund for the Board of Agriculture. It transfers the child nutrition programs division of the State Department of Education to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. The measure modifies the powers and duties of the State Board of Education to remove references to the National School Lunch Act. It repeals a section of law relating to apportionment of school lunch matching and program funds.
