**Bill Analysis**

SB 1638 prohibits any pharmacist from refusing to fill a valid prescription, and a licensed practitioner from refusing to dispense a drug, solely on the grounds that the pharmacist or practitioner believes the patient intends to use the drug or drugs for off-label use. The State Board of Pharmacy or relevant regulatory board is directed to immediately revoke the license of the pharmacist or practitioner and fine such persons \$100,000.00 per occurrence.
