Bill Analysis

SB 1640 directs each school district library in the state to provide an effective library media program with a balanced collection of print materials, nonprint materials, multimedia resources, and equipment and supplies. It directs each school district board of education to adopt and post on the district's website a comprehensive written policy that guides selection, deselection, and reconsideration of library media materials. The measure directs school district library, media center, media materials, equipment, and related school staff to be available to students and staff throughout the school day.
