**Bill Analysis**

SB 1642 requires practitioners to inform patients, prior to the administration of a vaccine, of the ingredients in the vaccine and whether the vaccine manufacturer used fetal cell lines in the research or production of the vaccine. Additionally, the measure requires the administering practitioner to obtain informed consent from the patient. The measure provides that if the licensing board of a practitioner finds that the practitioner violated the provisions of this measure, the board shall immediately revoke the license of the practitioner and fine the practitioner \$100,000.00 for each occurrence.

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
