**Bill Analysis**

SB 166 eliminates the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board and moves sponsorship of statewide virtual charter schools to the State Board of Education effective July 1, 2022. The measure allows a virtual charter school applicant that has been denied sponsorship by the State Board of Education to submit a revised application for reconsideration and provides a timeline for reconsideration. The measure also gives the State Board of Education authority over the Statewide Virtual Charter School Revolving Fund and replaces subsequent references to the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board with the State Board of Education. Additionally, the measure repeals language establishing the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board and its meeting requirements.
