**Bill Analysis**

The CS for SB 1673 modifies income qualifications for the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program (OHLAP), also known as Oklahoma's Promise. It states that beginning with eighth, ninth, tenth, or eleventh grade students who are enrolled in a public or private school or students between the ages of 13 and 16 who are educated by other means who apply for the program in the 2022-23 school year, the federal adjusted gross income of the student's parent(s) cannot exceed: \$60,000.00 per year if the parent(s) have 2 or fewer dependent children; \$70,000.00 per year if the parent(s) have 3-4 dependent children; and \$80,000.00 per year if the parent(s) have 5 or more dependent children.
