**Bill Analysis**

SB 1682 modifies the background check requirements for persons applying for pretrial release. The measure requires such checks to use records from the Oklahoma State Courts Network, the Department of Corrections, National Crime Information Center, when available, and any other records available to determine any past or current criminal charges and for the pretrial program to make a written report that lists any current criminal charges or failure to appear for any hearing. The measure also allows individuals accused or detained for charges relating to certain crimes to be eligible for pretrial if a hearing was conducted and any victim of the crime has been allowed to be present and be heard concerning the release. The measure provides that the monthly report provided to the presiding judge of the judicial district shall be an open record available to the public upon request and that it must have the name, case number and charge of each person released to the program or who failed to fulfill the program requirements.
