Bill Analysis

SB 1687 provides that certain dollar amounts set in the Uniform Consumer Code as they relate to loan charges shall be designated as subject to change and shall change according to and to the extent of changes in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers: U.S. City Average, All Items, 1982- 84=100. The Index for December 2021 shall be deemed the Reference Base Index. The measure also provides loan charges that may be made on loans with a principal of \$1,620.00 or less, instead of \$300.00 or less, may be charged in different amounts as outlined in the measure.
