**Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 1698 provides that disclosure of confidential information presented or discussed in an executive session of a public body shall subject the violator to criminal sanctions unless disclosed in a judicial proceeding or individual proceedings pursuant to Article II of the Administrative Procedures Act. The measure clarifies that documents subject to disclosure shall not be deemed to contain confidential information solely due to the use or discussion of such records during an executive session.
