Bill Analysis

SB 1745 increases the maximum fine for persons found to have entered any state or federal wildlife refuge or Wildlife Management Area with dog, gun, or bow to hunt without a permit from \$100.00 to \$1,000.00 and eliminates the minimum fine for the first violation. The measure authorizes the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission to revoke a person's hunting license for 2nd and subsequent violations. Persons entering a wildlife refuge area to hunt shall notify the Department of Wildlife Conservation before entering any refuge or Wildlife Management Area by electronic notification through the Department's application.
