Bill Analysis

SB 1747 establishes procedures for any person pursuing claims for damages to medical marijuana plants. The measure provides that such persons may establish value of the plants based upon the stage of growth of the plant, using data from the most recently submitted monthly yield and sales report, or the value of plants based on average production over a 5-year period. Aerial applicators shall not be liable for damages to marijuana plants grown indoors or in a greenhouse so long as the aerial applicator was not reckless in the application and provided notice to the licensed indoor or greenhouse grower prior to application. The measure also directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to establish a real-time market value for marijuana plants.
