Bill Analysis

SB 1765 directs the Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission to check information made available by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to determine whether a motor vehicle is subject to an open recall prior to issuing a motor vehicle registration or mailing a motor vehicle registration renewal notice. If the vehicle is subject to an open recall, the Commission shall notify the owner. After an owner of a motor vehicle receives notice that the motor vehicle is subject to a recall, the owner shall obtain the necessary repairs before the motor vehicle's next registration renewal. The owner must submit proof of the repair to the Commission. The measure authorizes the Director of the Commission to provide 6-month extensions for the registration of a motor vehicle subject to an open recall.
