Bill Analysis

SB 1793 prohibits any advertiser from inhibiting the publication or distribution of any content on the medium operated by the advertiser when the person or entity seeking to distribute such content compensates the advertiser for the publication or distribution of the content at a rate equal to or greater than the advertiser's rate. Attempts to inhibit the publication or distribution of such content will be deemed as injurious to competition. Advertisers may prohibit such content if the content constitutes a crime, encourages others to commit a crime, constitutes an invasion of privacy, or constitutes a violation of federal copyright law.
