Bill Analysis

SB 1798 creates a rebuttable presumption that an officer complied with agency or department policies and procedures during the arrest of an individual if during the encounter with, detention or arrest of the individual, the officer verbally communicated to the engaged officer that either he or she reached compliance with agency or department policy and procedures and that no further action would be required to subdue the individual or to secure the environment or that further action or conduct by the other officer would violate the policies or procedures of the agency or department. The provisions of this measure shall apply to instances in which the certification of the officer is subject to suspension or revocation.
