Bill Analysis

SB 1807 prohibits any person from occupying a campsite identified as “Reserved” by Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department staff or failing to vacate a campsite within a reasonable time after being notified of the campsite’s reserved status by Department staff. No person may enter an area of a state park that is identified as an area requiring payment of an entry fee without having first paid the entry fee. Violations of these provisions shall result in a fine of \$50.00 for the 1st offense, \$100.00 for the 2nd offense, and \$250.00 for any 3rd or subsequent offense. Monies collected in this manner shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund.
