**Bill Analysis**

SB 1810 authorizes district attorneys to bring an action in the name of the state, as parens patriae on behalf of natural persons residing in the attorney's district for appropriate injunctive or other equitable relief and to secure monetary damages for injury sustained by such natural persons to their business or property by reason of any violation of the Oklahoma Antitrust Reform Act unless the Attorney General already brought such an action forward under the same theory of relief.
