**Bill Analysis**

The CS for SB 1811 authorizes distiller, winemaker, brewer, and small brewer licensees to host off-site events. Distillers selling products at such events must have been sold to and shipped to an Oklahoma licensed wine and spirits wholesaler and then available for purchase by the Oklahoma licensed distiller. Each licensee may only host 4 off-site events per year. Applications to the ABLE Commission to host such events must include the location of the off-site event with a designated area within the location designed to provide an exclusive space. The holder of multiple small brewer licenses may sell beer produced at up to 3 breweries for which the licensee has a license. All manufacturer's licenses held by brewers during the first calendar year beginning October 1, 2018, shall automatically convert to brewer licenses and be deemed effective as of the date of the first issuance of the manufacturer's license. The measure also authorizes small farm winery licensees to host off-site events.
