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Bill Analysis

SB 1812 creates the Oklahoma Right to Shop Act. The measure establishes requirements for individual and small group insurance carriers upon approval of the next health insurance rate filing. These carriers must create a program in which enrollees are incentivized to shop for lower-cost providers. The measure also includes list of potential incentives such as cash payments or premium reductions. The measure requires that prior to offering such program, the program must be filed with the Insurance Commissioner. Additionally, the measure directs insurance carriers to create an interactive mechanism on their websites for comparison of health care services. The measure requires the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to conduct an analysis of the cost-effectiveness of implementing a shared savings incentive program or current enrollees of the Oklahoma Employees Insurance Plan no later than November 1, 2023.

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
