**Bill Analysis**

SB 1835 provides that any holder of a water permit issued by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board found to be out of compliance after a fact-finding investigation is conducted shall receive by either certified mail or electronic mail the written report that is provided to the complainant. The holder shall have 15 days after receiving the notice to resolve any cited issue, after which, the holder shall be fined \$2,000.00 per day until the issue or issues are resolved. If the holder is still not in compliance the 13<sup>th</sup> day after the report and citation are issued, the permit shall be revoked by the Board.
