Bill Analysis

SB 1841 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to deny licensing or suspend or revoke current license holder for any entity found to have violated state laws enforced by the Department of Environmental Quality, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, the Corporation Commission, or any other agency or commission of the state, or any local ordinance or regulation applicable to a medical marijuana business or inaccurate reporting or disclosures to municipal governments. The Authority shall notify any entity violating such laws or regulations and provide the entity with 30 days to resolve the violation prior to revoking, suspending, or denying licensure.
