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Bill Analysis

SB 1847 directs the Medical Marijuana Authority to develop procedures relating to process validation when testing for contaminants. Process validation shall be voluntary. Such procedures must include initial requirements to achieve process validation, requirements for licensees to track their marijuana and marijuana product inventory, requirements to record and document retention policies, requirements to maintain process validation when a licensee has made a significant process change, a process to revoke a licensee's authority to operate under process validation, punishment for willful violations of process validation, and an annual registration fee not to exceed \$2,500.00.

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
