**Bill Analysis**

SB 1852 modifies the duties of the Oklahoma Energy Initiative by requiring it to encourage new and existing energy uses, supply chain activity, and infrastructure. Additionally, the measure adds hydrogen production to the list of Oklahoma's core energy competencies. The measure provides that membership of the Initiative shall include representatives of the petroleum industry and the renewable energy industry and increases the total membership from 6 to 9 members.
