**Bill Analysis**

The FS for SB 197 allows a school district or technology center board of education candidate who receives more than 50% of the vote in a primary election to be seated at the first board meeting following the April election date. The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast in the board of education general election shall be elected to the office and following certification of election results shall be seated at the first meeting following the April election date. The measure also clarifies that the school district or technology center board of education must elect a president and vice president at the first meeting following the April election date.
