Bill Analysis

SB 235 deems any policy by a school district restricting a student from wearing tribal regalia during a high school graduation ceremony, provided the such conduct is motivated by the religious beliefs of the student, as a substantial burden to the free exercise of religion by the student. Additionally, the measure specifies that aesthetic uniformity shall not constitute a compelling governmental interest.
