Bill Analysis

SB 25 requires resentencing by a jury if the original sentence was imposed by a jury unless jury resentencing is waived by the defendant. The measure authorizes defendants to affirmatively waive resentencing before the appropriate trial court within 90 days of the appellate court order remanding for resentencing. The defendant cannot waive resentencing after the commencement of the resentencing hearing or trial. The measure stipulates that upon the defendant foregoing resentencing, the original sentence shall be reinstated by the court. The reinstated sentence may not be appealed.
