**Bill Analysis**

SB 327 caps the number of requests for reproduction a party may request at 30 as it relates to writings, drawings, graphs, charts, photographs, sound recordings, images, and other data or data compilations in court proceedings. If counsel believes more than 30 requests for reproduction are needed, counsel may work with opposing counsel to reach a written stipulation as to a reasonable number of additional requests. The measure outlines procedures counsel may take if no written agreement can be agreed to.

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
