**Bill Analysis**

SB 334 provides that persons convicted of stealing goods valued at less than \$1,000.00 for the first time shall be subject to community service and a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$500.00. For second and subsequent convictions, the measure provides that such a person shall be subject to a term of imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding 30 days and a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$500.00. The measure modifies the time period by the value of goods may be aggregated when determining the appropriate punishment for persons convicted of larceny. The measure increases the period from 90 days to 180 days.

**CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 334 adds language relating to first time convictions for petty larceny.
