**Bill Analysis**

SB 338 modifies the requirements for certain positions in the Department of Public Safety. The measure provides that no person can be appointed unless the person is a citizen and of good moral character. The Commissioner is to determine minimum qualifications for all positions. The measure prohibits commissioned officers of the Department from being a candidate for any political office or contribute any money or other thing of value to any political campaign.

**House Amendments**

HA's to the measure adds language prohibiting any commissioned officer of the Department from running as a candidate for political office or contributing any money or other thing of value to a political campaign.
