Bill Analysis

SB 36 defines “reasonable probability” as it relates to a petitioner’s conviction absent favorable results of a DNA test to mean a petitioner showing by a preponderance of the evidence that he or she would not have been prosecuted or convicted if exculpatory results had been obtained through DNA testing. Exculpatory results include, but are not limited to, evidence that would impeach a witness.
