Bill Analysis

SB 372 authorizes the district courts and the Department of Human Services to revoke the occupational, professional, or business license as well as the driving privileges of any person for failing to pay child support. The measure outlines the procedures for revoking a person's driving privileges. If the person failing to provide child support is a lawyer, the measure also authorizes the Department and the courts to refer such a person to the State Bar Association. The measure authorizes persons who face the suspension of a license or privilege to request a hearing within 30 days to show cause that the licenses of the obligor should not be suspended or revoked.
