Bill Analysis

SB 374 adds the category of “small farm producer” as it relates to the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act. The measure defines a small farm producer as a person producing no less than 100 vines of sound ripe grapes, 1,000 pounds of other sound ripe fruit or berries, or 100 pounds of honey. The measure also creates a license for such producers and authorizes the holder thereof to contract with a small farm winery license holder to manufacture wine exclusively from produce grown by the licensee, conduct wine tastings, sell wine manufactured from produce grown by the licensee, and sell and serve Oklahoma-manufactured wine. The fee for a Small Farm Producer License is set at \$75.00.
