Bill Analysis

SB 416 provides for the county election board to change a voter's registered address to match the address the voter indicated on his or her driver license, provided the voter does not decline the change after receiving notice of the change. Any voter younger than 22 years of age may indicate on the change of address form that the change of address on his or her driver license is not for registration purposes. The measure also directs the Secretary of the State Election Board and the Department of Public Safety to prescribe a system by which a motor license agency may determine a voter's registration address matches the address listed on the driver license and whether the person is registered to vote.
