Bill Analysis

SB 425 creates the Advisory Task Force on Prevention of Human Trafficking and Child Exploitation. The Task Force shall be comprised of 13 members and provides for its members to receive travel reimbursements from their appointing authority. The measure requires the Task Force to study human trafficking, prostitution, and child exploitation in Oklahoma and to make recommendations to the Legislature on methods and laws to enhance and fund the efforts of law enforcement or community groups. The Task Force shall report its findings to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House on or before February 1, 2022.
