Bill Analysis

SB 437 requires rather than allows school districts to provide remediation courses beginning in the 2021-22 school year to high school students who score below the benchmarks on subject-area portions of the ACT or below equivalent scores on the SAT. The measure states that remediation may include but is not limited to extended instructional time during the day, a summer academy, tutoring, online coursework, repetition of any course that corresponds to a subject area in which the student scored below the benchmark or other supplementary services.
