Bill Analysis

SB 449 prohibits law enforcement agencies from using an international mobile subscriber identity catcher (IMSI-catcher), defined as a mobile device that captures the signaling information of electronic communication devices within the vicinity, to obtain an individual's real-time or historical electronic communication device location information without first obtaining a search warrant. Any incidental data captured with an IMSI-catcher will be inadmissible in a court of law. The Oklahoma Department of Corrections is exempt from the provisions of this measure.
