Bill Analysis

SB 517 provides for continuing virtual education of students who are the dependent children of a member of the active uniformed military services of the United States on full-time active duty status or who are the dependent children of a member of the military reserve on active duty orders who are transferred to a military installation outside of the state. The measure directs school district boards of education and the governing boards of public charter schools that offer full-time virtual education and the governing boards of virtual charter schools to exempt such students from a tuition fee requirement for nonresident, nontransferred students. Additionally, the measure directs school district boards of education and the governing boards of public charter schools that offer full-time virtual education and the governing boards of virtual charter schools to adopt a policy to allow such students to continuing participating in virtual education for the remainder of the school year in which the transfer to an out-of-state military installation takes place.
