**Bill Analysis**

SB 53 removes language allowing a proposed charter school that has been denied sponsorship by a school district to appeal to the State Board of Education for sponsorship. It prohibits the State Board of Education from sponsoring charter schools, except when the applicant is the Office of Juvenile Affairs, beginning July 1, 2022. The measure directs charter schools currently sponsored by the State Board of Education to enter into a contract with a new sponsor by July 1, 2022, or the charter school will be dissolved.
